1	<b>CHATEAU DE BLOMAC</b> 2003/04 (B) Cuvee St. Etienne, Minervois A.C. This complex French red wine is soft, rich, and velvety. It tastes of wild blackberries and vanilla.	£11.75		£2.90
2	<b>CABERNET SAUVIGNON</b> Paloma de la Paz, 2006/07 (B/C) From the Rapel Valley in Chile, this red tastes of dark red fruits, bramble, cassis, and some spice - backed up by soft easy tannins.	£9.95		£2.80
3	<b>MALBEC</b> La Rareza, 2006/07 (C) This Argentinean red is medium bodied and mellow, with cherry, oak, and plum flavours. It goes well with game dishes and red meat.	£9.95		£2.80
4	<b>MERLOT</b> Santa Ema, 2006/07 (C/D) This Chilean red is fruity, round, and full bodied, with a nose of cherries, plums, and herbs, enhanced by a touch of smokey oak.	£11.75	£6.95	£2.90

5	<b>SAUVIGNON BLANC</b> Torreon de Paredes 2007 (2) Dryish but not flinty, this Chilean white is straw yellow in colour and has a peach and citrus fruit bouquet. It has a fresh, clean, fruity taste.	£9.95	£6.95	£2.80
6	<b>SEMILLON CHARDONNAY</b> Jacobite Ridge, 2007 (2-3) This creamy Australian white is full bodied, fruity, and robust. With a touch of oak, it is backed up with soft tropical flavours.	£9.95		£2.80
7	<b>CHENIN BLANC</b> Robertson, 2007 (2) A South African white with an aroma of melon and lychees. It tastes of soft tropical fruit flavours, and has an elegant, refreshing citrus finish.	£9.95		£2.80
8	<b>SATINELA</b> Marques de Caceres 2006/07 (6) This Spanish white is the sweetest wine on our list. Made from Viura and Malvasia grapes, it is fruity and sweet, without being syrupy.	£11.50		£2.90
