<p><b>BUDWEISER (330ml ) 4.8% Abv</b> Beechwood aged “King of Beers” brewed in Saint Louis since 1876. A medium bodied, clear, crisp and smooth lager.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>CARLSBERG EXPORT (500ml) 4.8% Abv</b> “Probably the best lager in the world” from Copenhagen. A refreshing, strong fruity flavoured Danish Pilsner.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>STELLA ARTOIS (500ml) 4.8% Abv</b> Premium Pilsner from the Artois Den Hoom Brewery, based in Leuven in Belgium. Exceptional clarity with a spicy hop character.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>PERONI Nastro Azzurro (330ml) 5.1% Abv</b> Premium Italian pale lager. Crisp, refreshing with a delicate balance of bitterness and citrus, with spicy aromatic notes.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>SCHIEHALLION PILSNER (500ml) 4.8% Abv</b> An oak conditioned craft lager, which is crisp dry and refreshing, and has a lingering grapefruit finish. From the Harviestoun Brewery in Alva, Scotland, it won the accolade of WBA Best Pilsner for 2008.</p>	£5.00
<p><b>BECK’S BLUE (ALCOHOL FREE) (275ml)</b> An alcohol free version of the classic German lager, from the Bremen Brewery.</p>	£3.00
<p><b>ERDINGER (ALMOST ALCOHOL FREE) (500ml)</b> An isotonic, vitamin rich, reduced calorie, bottle fermented wheat lager, brewed in Bavaria since 1886. It has less than half a percent alcohol by volume.</p>	£5.00

<p><b>GUINNESS DRAUGHT Can (500ml) 4.2% Abv</b> Original Irish stout, brewed since 1759, at the Saint James Gate brewery in Dublin. It is a smooth balance of sweet malt, roasted barley, and delicate hops.</p>	£4.00
<p><b>BELHAVEN BEST (440ml) 3.2% Abv</b> This beer has been crafted at the Belhaven Brewery in Dunbar since 1779. It is a beautifully balanced, smooth and creamy, honey coloured beer.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>JOHN SMITHS EXTRA SMOOTH (440ml) 3.6% Abv</b> This has been made at the Tadcaster Brewery in North Yorkshire since 1852. It is a full flavoured ale with a cereal character, combined with equal bitterness and fruit, and has a creamy smooth finish.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>MCEWANS EXPORT (500ml) 4.5% Abv</b> A premium Scottish Ale, full bodied and sweet with a roast flavour. First brewed in the 1860’s and exported in casks to quench the thirst of workers under the hot Indian sun. A reminder of home.</p>	£3.30

<p><b>MOULIN OLD REMEDIAL (500ml) 5.2% Abv</b></p> <p>The Moulin Inn Brewery is based in the old coach house and stables, with the nearby original inn dating back to 1695. One of Scotland's earliest micro-breweries, this is a medium bodied, smooth golden ale.</p>	£5.50
<p><b>MOULIN BRAVEHEART (500ml) 4% Abv</b></p> <p>A sister beer to Old Remedial, this is a dark brown ale, brewed with honey and roast malt. It is named in honour of William Wallace, Braveheart of Scotland.</p>	£5.50
<p><b>COLONSAY 80 SHILLING (500ml) 4.2% Abv</b></p> <p>A classic Scots ale from the island of Colonsay. Made with dark roasted barley, it has a chocolate malt character with a slightly savoury note - perhaps from the peat in the water or the sea salt in the air.</p>	£5.50
CIDERS	Price
<p><b>MAGNERS (500ml) 4.5% Abv</b></p> <p>From the Magners cider mill, based in Clonmel, Tipperary. This is the original sweet Irish cider using seventeen varieties of sharp, sweet, and bitter apples. This cider is matured in the dark for two years.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>STRONGBOW (500ml) 5% Abv</b></p> <p>This is a dry apple cider, made in Hereford since 1911. It is named after a Norman Knight nicknamed "Strongbow", who favoured his archers in battle.</p>	£3.30
<p><b>KOPPARBERG PEAR (ALCOHOL FREE) (500ml)</b></p> <p>This cider is named after the central Swedish town where production first started in 1882. The low mineral content of the local water allows the natural pure taste of the fruit to come through unaltered.</p>	£3.30
